Job Purpose

To provide crew cover during illness and holiday. Cover may be requested in advance, or at short notice, with no obligation to accept work.

To assist the Head of Stage and Deputy Head of Stage in the smooth and safe running of the backstage area during performances. The Show Crew will be responsible for the moving of scenery and prop pieces and will take a number of show specific positions, this will include learning various plots to facilitate the efficient running of the show.

This role involves evening, afternoon and weekend work.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

Operation and Maintenance

- Participate in performances, as arranged with the Head of Stage. Each show has a preset call: at 1pm on Sunday, 5pm on Monday, 5.30pm on Wednesday, 12.30pm on Thursday, 5.30pm on Friday and 12.30pm on Saturday.
- Learn a variety of show plots.
- Assist in the service and maintenance of the stage and backstage areas to the highest standard and to bring any difficulties or health and safety hazards to the attention of the Head of Stage or Chief Electrician.

Health and Safety

- Be fully aware of the evacuation procedures in the event of a theatre evacuations.
- Be aware of and ensure all relevant Health and Safety requirements are followed and abide by the company's Health and Safety Policy.
- Ensure all health and safety requirements and risk management systems are strictly adhered to when operating machinery, or when working in an area where such machinery is being operated by others.

Other

- Undertake any training appropriate to the position.
- To comply with all Company Policies and Procedures, including but not limited to all HR Policies, Inclusion, Diversity and Equality Policy, Sustainability Policy and the Health and Safety Policy.
- Undertake any reasonable duties during working hours as required by the Head of Stage, their Deputy and the Senior Management team.
